## Scams

We still have residents getting scammed on the phone. The tactics of the scammers are pretty much the same as in recent years. They prey on fear and doubt to trick victims to give them money or to give them information so they can make them a victim of Identity Theft.

Do not answer numbers you don't know. Let voicemail pick it up. Valid callers will leave a message. Sometimes the scammer will too. If someone claims to be a government entity and is demanding money over the phone, IT IS A SCAM. If in doubt, call the government agency in question – but look up the phone number yourself. Same with utilities like O&R, PSE&G, etc. Do not trust the caller ID number.

NEVER give out information about yourself over the phone. NEVER make payments without checking the validity of the claim. NEVER get tricked into buying gift cards or making Western Union transfers. These are scams designed to be difficult to track.
