## The Mayor's Corner

The heavy rain during the month of July left us with several downed trees and power outages through out the town. We often forget that when power is lost in a particular grid, everyone loses power, including businesses. Orange & Rockland understands this and they have been very responsive and proactive, before, during and after the storms. It is also my responsibility to set expectations when we are hit by multiple storms. Our resources are limited and often limited by the magnitude of the storms. When trees are downed and entangled with live wires, nothing can be done until the power is cut to the wires and confirmed with on-site field representative. And when we have a power outage, it is best that you contact O&R first so it's logged in. Calling me or borough hall doesn't help or expedite the matter. As for the downed trees, our first priority is public safety and access to the roads for emergency. You will often see cut trees left on the side of the roads for days.

That is because our crew is working around the town opening up the roads, and when all that's done is when they come back around and pick up the downed trees.

We are told every year that more damaging storms and hurricanes are coming. We try to plan to the best that we can and we all appreciate everyone's cooperation and patience.

# Montvale Police Department



## Board of Health Rabies Vaccination Clinic - Save The Date

Montvale Board of Health is pleased to announce that the 2021 Rabies Vaccination Clinic will be held on Saturday, November 6, 2021 at the DPW Garage, Memorial Drive, Montvale.

Dogs are welcome on non-retractable leashes, controlled by an individual 18 years and older, between hours of 10:00am to 11:00am. Cats are welcome in carriers between 11:00am to 11:30am.

Dr. Cohen-Grady, DVM, will be administering the rabies vaccines and Tyco Animal Control Officers will provide animal assistance. Northwest Bergen Regional Commission will supply the vaccines.

Vaccinations will be provided free of charge and licensing will not be offered at this time. Reminder to all pet owners, an annual license is required and if you have not licensed your pet for this year you are encouraged to do so. Licensing your pet may be done at borough hall or thru the mail.

2022 License registration will begin in January 2022.

Board of Health will require attendees to wear masks and are limiting one individual per pet.
