To determine whether your at-home COVID-19 test is part of the most recent expiration date extension, visit the [At-Home OTC COVID-19 Diagnostic Tests](#) page on the FDA's website. On this page, locate the corresponding image of the test kit you have and refer to the last column for expiration date information. If the brand of your specific test has any date extensions, click the hyperlink, which will bring you to a document listing the lot numbers that are part of the extension.
