Pet Licensing Information

It's that time of year again – time to renew your pet license and this year, we've made it easier than ever. You can now renew your license online! Log onto www.montvale.org and click on the Board of Health page and look for Online Pet License Payment. You can renew your license, make your payment, provide your rabies certificate, even upload a photo of your pet.

Licensing Fees Per Pet:

- Spayed/Neutered Pet: \$18
- Non-spayed/Non-neutered Pet: \$21
- Pet Owners Age 55+: \$10

Renew Online

- Pay online by credit card - a convenience fee will be charged for credit card payments
- Scan and upload proof rabies vaccination
- Upload a photo of your pet (optional)

Renew by Mail or In Person

- Make your check payable to the Borough of Montvale
- Include a copy of rabies vaccination

Rabies vaccinations must be valid through November 1, 2022. Licenses are to be renewed by February 28, 2022 or you will incur a late fee of \$10 per pet (\$5 per pet for ages 55+) starting March 1st.

There will be a \$10 fee for replacement badges. The Recreation Department has updated the tennis court's magnetic card reader to a proximity reader. Badges will no longer need to be swiped, but rather just moved within a close proximity to the reader. Pickleball Court Badges

Field Use

Applications and Hold Harmless forms must be completed and returned to the Recreation Department, Attn: Lisa Dent, with Liability Insurance and payment. Forms are available online and at the Borough Hall front counter. Permits will not be issued if the application is incomplete. All organizations must receive an approved permit from Lisa Dent prior to any field use.
