This request was made in the form of a motion by J. Landzberg and second by L. Hopper. A letter will be forward to PB Secretary and the Borough Administrator. The new establishment that opened in Borough offering IV drips does not require any inspections by this Board. However, the Board discussed the offerings of this retail establishment.
